Internal Progression Criteria

In order for students in Foundation learning, Level 2 or Level 3 Year 1 to progress onto next year, they must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Attendance 85% & Punctuality 90% (Term 3 attendance)
- 2. Achievement on current course/s including English & Maths grade 4+ (where applicable)
- 3. Good behaviour
- 4. Good reference from Progress Tutor and Teachers

If a learner fails to meet some of the criteria, they would be required to have an interview meeting with the Director of Curriculum/Curriculum Manager with the meeting outcome approved by the Vice Principal for Teaching and Quality.
